OBJECTIVES: The project work aims to enable students to: identify a legal problem and provide its remedy select relevant legal sources and conduct research analyse and distinguish between types of cases apply case laws and relevant statutory laws.

METHODOLOGY-: The student is required to select any 3 decided cases related to the curriculum where one must be civil in nature, one criminal and one constitutional in character.

The research on the cases must include the following points:
