PROJECT GUIDELINES for Class XII Legal Profession in India Detailed Guideline given below for reference

INTRODUCTION: The student is required to do a project on 'Understanding Case Laws'

OBJECTIVES: The project work aims to enable students to: identify a legal problem and provide its remedy select relevant legal sources and conduct research analyse and distinguish between types of cases apply case laws and relevant statutory laws.

METHODOLOGY:- The student is required to select any 3 decided cases related to the curriculum where one must be civil in nature, one criminal and one constitutional in character.

The research on the cases must include the following points:

- Name of the case
- Parties to the case
- Citation to the case
- Bench Nature of the case (Civil, Criminal or Constitutional)
- Facts of the case and issues involved
- Decision of the case including Ratio Decidendi and Obiter Dicta.
